

Graphing Review

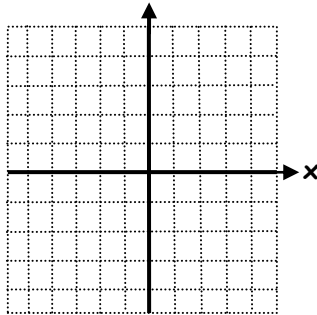
1. Graph the following on the same set of axes using the slope-intercept method.

a) $y = 3x - 3$

b) $y = -2x + 4$

c) $y = \frac{2}{3}x - 2$

d) $2x - 4y = 4$



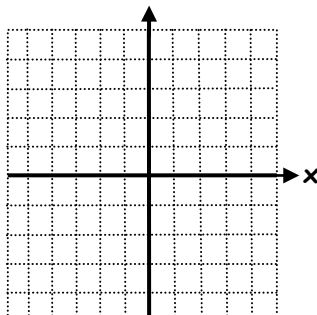
2. Determine the x and y-intercepts and then graph each linear relation.

a) $x + 3y = 3$

b) $-x + 2y = 6$

c) $5x + 3y - 15 = 0$

d) $3y = 2x + 6$



3. Create a table of values and graph each relation.

a) $y = 2x^2$

b) $y = x^3$

c) $y = x^2 + x$

d) $y = \left(\frac{1}{2}\right)^x$
